Available for all players even if you are registered with another Club for Saturday Cricket

Your child will be supplied with their own uniquely numbered Takapuna Cricket Club Cap when you register with the club. The number stays with you during your time paying the Friday night format. For new members Caps will be handed out on Muster Day Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> October.

The Cap Number corresponds to each child's registration and the school they represent, it also allows the club to attribute your child's results to the right school. This means every run scored, every run saved and every wicket taken has an impact on the overall school's performance.

- Individual stats will be published against each Cap Number on our Kookaburra Cup Web Page.

- If your child requires a replacement cap you may purchase another (with another number for \$15). All children must wear their cap on a Friday.

### **KCUP BLITZ** – Primarily Ages 10,11,12,13

Boys School Years 2018 - Year 5 – 6 Dispensation for Year 7's

Girls School Years 2018 - Year 6 – 8 Dispensation for Year 9's

Teams maybe mixed genders and of mixed ages.

2018 Year 4's must start are not eligible for Blitz but maybe elevated to Blitz as a team.

The final score is determined by Total Runs LESS 3 runs for outs. Winners have the highest net runs.

### **WINNING THE KCUP BASH**

Cap Numbers record points which are attributed to your School.

School with the highest points will win the KCUP BASH CUP each term.

All school members accumulate points for their school regardless of what team they are in.

### **WINNING THE KOOKABURRA CUP**

BASH Points for those playing for a primary school are also added to the points recorded in the Competition Grade. The Primary School with the most points wins the Kookaburra Cup.

## **THE GAME**

Everyone bats in partnerships of 4 overs.

- 3 runs if you go out then swap to non-facing
- 5 School Points are given to the bowler who gets a wicket

Fielders rotate clockwise after each over so everyone keeps for 2 overs.

Everyone Bowls 2 overs (Bowlers restricted to 3 - 5 steps)

- Max 9 a side ([see link to how 9 works](#))

Double runs for hitting straight into the MAX Zone
