The Kookaburra Cup is the name of our Friday Night Format. Our goal is to help boys and girls learn the skills of the game and have fun in doing so. The structure (and cost) of this competition has been designed to give as many children as possible a chance to experience cricket and for the family to have a fun social experience.

REGISTRATONS

Registrations will remain open throughout the season.

IMPORTANT Your child will not be assigned to the Friday Night Format until payment has been received. We suggest you pay online as you register.

Payments can be made to TDCC via BNZ Takapuna, AC No: 02 0272 0042810 00 including your child's name as a reference. However, it can take up to 2 weeks to confirm your membership.

CLUB CAP

Your child will be supplied with their own uniquely numbered Takapuna Cricket Club Cap. The number stays with you during your time paying the Friday night format.

For new members Caps will be handed out on Muster Day Sunday 28th October.

The Cap Number corresponds to each child's registration and the school they represent, it also allows the Competition Manager to attribute your child's results to the right school. This means every run scored, every run saved and every wicket taken has an impact on the overall school's performance. Regardless of which schools make up your team. Even if you move teams.

- Individual stats will be published against each Cap Number on our Kookaburra Cup Web Page and emailed to you in the weekly newsletter.

- If your child requires a replacement cap you may purchase another (with another number for \$20). All children must wear their cap on a Friday.

- Each Friday we will have a Cap Number Prize draw.

MODULES

DEVELOPMENT Squad – Primarily Ages 5-6-7

If your child is in Year 1 or Year 2 at school they will automatically be placed in this Squad.

The *initial* emphasis is to upskill the children so they can compete in the Competition Grade. The Development Squad will be managed by our Head Coach and other Takapuna Club Players and coached from our Coaching Pathway Scheme. This is a great opportunity for these kids to work with some quality coaches who also love working with children.

We do welcome parent help, however parents or teenagers who want to get involved in coaching will need to attend our coaching course.

Initially the Development Squad will be split into 12 Coloured Groups by age range and assumed skill levels. The makeup of these squads are not set in stone, if a child wants to move into a different squad it is no problem.

These younger children are managed in a completely different way than those playing a game. As in our experience the younger kids often don't have the concentration to play in a game where it involves fielding and waiting to bat. They are kept very busy and are often exhausted after 90 minutes.

OUR GOAL: Is to develop these children so they can be a feeder for the Competition Grade. Often we will pull children from this grade to play when teams are short of players.

Usually after the first term we will make up 2 more teams from the Development Squad to play in the Competition Grade.

DEVELOPMENT SQUAD COACHING SCHEDULE

- Focus on learning bowling and batting skills while playing fast passed fun games.

If you think your child would not benefit from this module contact the Competition Manager.

COMPETITION Grade – Primarily Ages 7-8-9

If your child is in Year 3 or Year 4 at school they will automatically be placed in this format.

This grade will compete in mixed boys/girls teams of mixed ages. The winning team will have the highest net runs. The final score is determined by TOTAL RUNS less 3 runs for each out. **a**

KCUP Bash – Primarily Ages 10,11 & 12

Boys School Years 2018 Year 5 – 6 Dispensation for Year 7's

Boys School Years 2018 Year 6 – 8 Dispensation for Year 9's

This grade can be mixed boys/girls teams of mixed ages. The winning team will have the highest net runs. The final score is determined by TOTAL RUNS less 3 runs for each out.

All members from a school accumulate points for their school regardless of what team they are in.

Required from Parents: Appoint a Manager single point of contact who will coordinate within their team if they are short a player.

WHAT TO WEAR

All children are required to wear their Takapuna Cap.

Children are to also wear their blue Takapuna T-Shirt that they will receive as part of their registration.

If your child is selected to play Sunday Representative Cricket then they will need to have a White Takapuna Club Shirt. Official White Takapuna Club Shirt can be purchased from Cricket Express Albany for \$35.

ON THE NIGHT

Development Squad: Each squad is called by a name of a Black Cap. There will be signs displaying each colour. Each child is required to sit in a line behind their colour.

Competition Grade: Simply check your weekly email or go to www.kookaburracup.co.nz to check where you are playing and turn up to your field and wait for your team. Ideally one parent will rally the kids and get them warmed up.

Your Match Bag will be on your pitch when you arrive at the grounds each Friday. Use the gear in the bag to warm up but also share the gear with your opposition team. If you need a ball send a child over to the control centre on the deck. Please encourage your children to put all balls back into the bags after the game.

At 5.30pm a Pitch Manager who will be wearing a Yellow High Viz Vest will turn up to your field. They will be responsible for the gear bag, overseeing the Toss and starting the game on time they'll also be there to help children out with technique.

There will be one score sheet for each team which the Pitch Manager will use to score the game.

One parent of the fielding team will be required to stand at Square Leg to help kids rotate after each over. The more parent help we have the more our Pitch Managers can coach your children.

SATURDAY / SUNDAY REP GAMES

We will be looking to recruit a Year 3 and Year 4 Rep Squad to play the following matches:

Rep Players must play in a Takapuna Official Players Shirt available from Cricket Express in Albany for \$35. We will be having some preseason activity which will help us to identify representative players.

- North Shore Inter-Club

We will appoint both a Year 3 and Year 4 squad to play 2 games against East Coast Bays, North Shore and Birkenhead clubs during the season.

This competition is sanctioned by North Harbour, the winner of this competition will receive a Trophy for their Club. Each child must play their age, there are no dispensations to play up a grade.

The entire grade will be communicated to when trials are set.

NOTE: Saturday / Sunday Players must have a Takapuna Club Shirt and or white short or longs.
