CLUB CAPS

New players to the club who are registered for the Development and Competition grades will be supplied with their own uniquely numbered Takapuna Cricket Club Cap when they register with the club. The number stays with you during your time paying the Friday Night Format.

The Cap Number corresponds to each child's registration and the school they represent and their team. The Number also allows the club to attribute your child's results to the right school. This means that regardless whether your team is winning or losing every run scored, every run saved and every wicket taken has an impact on the overall school's performance.

TEAM MANAGER

Teams just need to appoint a single person who will contact the club if they are short a player. If your team has 7 players simply play with 7 children, the child who scores the lowest amount of runs simply bats again. If the other team has an extra player then teams may loan a player to the other team.
