**NO CAPS OR SHIRTS AVAILABLE FOR PICKUP ON FRIDAY (Avail Wednesday 3-5pm)**

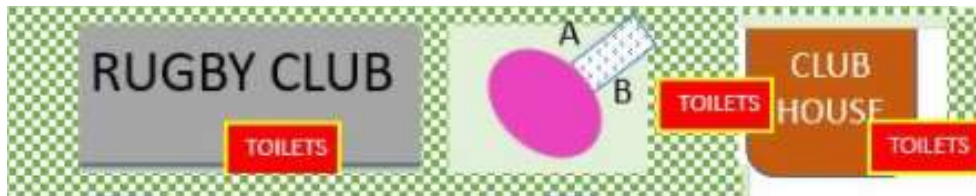
#### **TOILET FACILITIES**

Children must be accompanied by an adult.

**Onewa 1 Players:** QR Code Scanning reqd to enter Club toilets via side door.

**Onewa 2 Players:** QR Code Scanning reqd to enter Club Changing Room toilets.

**Rugby Club Toilets** Only for Under 11 Girls



#### **C19 QR SCANNING**

On the day club coaches will provide a laminated card with the C19 Tracer QR Code for parents to scan which will tell the Ministry of Health that you have come to the club fields.

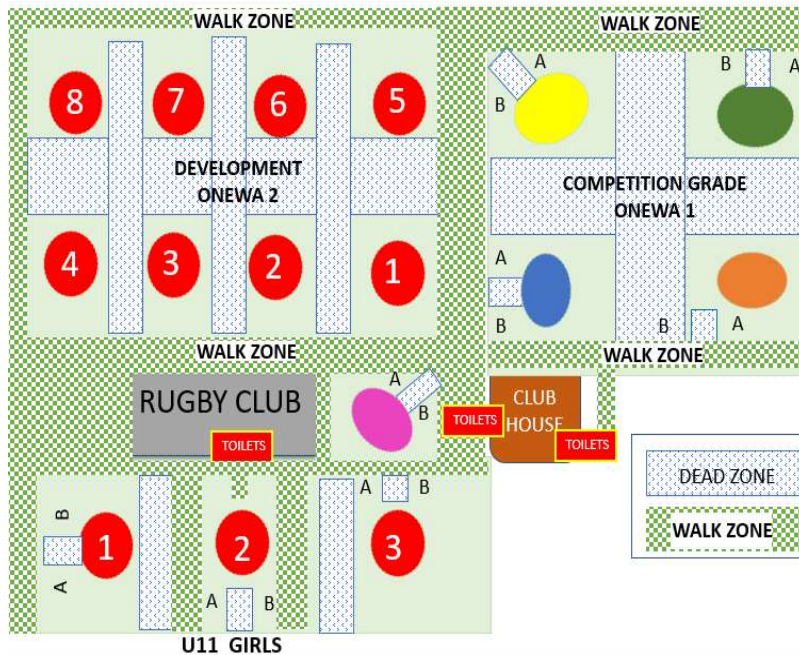
- Parents will need to scan another QR Code to enter the Club Toilets.
